

Health & Safety Policy

Effective immediately, all commercial businesses providing goods or services directly to the public in Bexar County must create a Health and Safety Policy that requires employees and customers wear face coverings if they cannot maintain physical distancing.

Commercial businesses must post the policy in a visible location to notify employees and customers by Monday, June 22. Violators may face a maximum fine of \$1,000.

Mayor Ron Nirenberg signed the [addendum to his Eighth Emergency Declaration](#) (PDF, 251KB), which adopts Bexar County Judge Nelson Wolff's [Executive Order NW-10](#).

Business owners are encouraged to take the "Greater, SAfer, Together" pledge and download a toolkit with printable materials. The pledge requires the use of face coverings by employees and visitors and asks businesses to commit to other health and safety protocols including physical distancing, temperature checks and other CDC recommendations. Businesses that take the pledge may post their commitment to be in compliance with Bexar County's requirement to develop and post a Health and Safety Policy.
